2020 Art Competition

Rules and Registration

Goals:

- ❖ To inspire students to create a piece of artwork that represents what it might have been like in the Renaissance era.
- ❖ Encourage students to explore their creativity through art.

Art Guidelines:

- ❖ Artwork must represent that of the 16th Century life, in either the Royalty, Nobility, or Peasant class.
- ❖ Students may use Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, Colored Pencil, Graphite Pencil, Charcoal or Ink.
- ❖ Each entry must securely attach a 3x5 card with the student's name, teacher's name, address, daytime phone number, email address, category and title of artwork.
- ❖ Artwork may be no larger than 24" X 24". Frames and mattes are not required.
- ❖ Artist must provide a stand on which the artwork can be displayed for judging.
- ❖ Entries must be original and may not violate any US Copyright Laws. Any entry reproduced is a violation and will be disqualified from the competition.

Registration Information:

- ❖ Enclosed registration form declaring intent to compete must be received by the Student Days Department no later than April 1, 2020.
- ❖ The student's school must be registered and paid to attend Student Days at Scarborough Renaissance Festival® no later than April 1, 2020.
- ❖ Students entering in the Art Competition must be present at Student Days on April 28, 2020 to win.

Judging & Awards:

- ❖ Students participating in the Art Competition must check in, with their artwork, at the Wedding Garden inside the Front Gate upon arrival at Student Days on **April 28, 2020** by **10:00am**. This is necessary for the student to be eligible to participate in the competition.
- ❖ Anyone that shows up the **April 28, 2020** and did not submit the intent to compete form by the deadline of **April 1, 2020** will be disqualified.
- ❖ Artists will be escorted or directed to the Village Green Corporate Picnic Area after check in where artwork will be displayed for judging. Artwork and display stands will be dropped off at this time.
- ❖ Judges will consist of approved educators, performers, and staff members by Scarborough Renaissance Festival®. All judges' decisions are final.
- ❖ Awards will be presented to the winners at the Royal Awards Ceremony held during the Student Days of events at 1:00pm on the Crown Stage.
- ❖ Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in each category. **All entries will be considered for Best in Show.*
- ❖ Artwork may be picked up after the Royal Awards Ceremony on Student Days in the Village Green Corporate Picnic Area.
- ❖ Any artwork remaining in the Village Green Corporate Picnic Area at 3:00pm will become property of Scarborough Renaissance Festival®.
